

PDT MACRON ADDRESSES FROM AD HOC MULHOUSE MILITARY HOSPITAL OF 30 BEDS

OVER COVID-19 OUTBREAK

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USPA NEWS - The Head of State went to the Mulhouse Field Military Hospital, whose visit lasted three hours. Mulhouse, (located 517 km from Paris and 475 km from Germany), was overwhelmed by the COVID-19 cases. Indeed, the Grand Est region is the most affected in France, since the spread of COVID-19 which has accelerated following the week of the Evangelist "MegaChurch" (From 17 to 24 February 20) which had gathered nearly two thousand (2000) people, in the Bourtzwiller district of Mulhouse. This event of one of the largest Protestant evangelical churches in France had invited faithful from all over France, including overseas, for a week of fasting and prayer, had not been canceled or postponed. Since the beginning of the epidemic in the Grand Est, 580 people have died including "people confirmed virologically positive for covid19 coronavirus as well as people not tested but whose death is reported to be a coronavirus infection." This development confirms that the situation is getting worse. REMARK DU PRESIDENT MACRON SUITE A LA VISITE DE HOPITAL MILITAIRE DE CAMPAGNE A MULHOUSE

Emmanuel Macron went, alone, without any minister by his side, this Wednesday, March 25, to the Mulhouse Field Military Hospital, installed this week in the parking lot of a hospital center in the city of the Grand region is submerged by victims of COVID-19. The visit lasted approximately three hours. Upon his arrival, President Macron immediately wore a mask for the first time since his visits since the COVID-19 epidemic, as well as the chief of staff and the other army officers who accompanied him. The Head of State, as "Commander in Chief" has exchanged with elected officials and staff of the Mulhouse hospital who have been tired and dedicated on the ground since the epidemic of COVID-19 was re-invented in France and particularly affects the Grand Est region, the largest "cluster" according to the ARS (Regional Health Agency)

This military equipment composed of gray tents includes a team of a hundred medical personnel can simultaneously treat 30 patients, knowing that 10 patients are already hospitalized there. The main doctor Antoine explained that this kind of military structure is usually reserved for war wounded and that "It is historic and exceptional in keeping with this exceptional health crisis", The balance sheet in France is weighed down with today 1,100 deaths from Covid-19 have been recorded at the hospital and 2,516 patients are in intensive care, with 407 deaths yesterday in the great east and 595 patients in intensive care in the region. PDT MACRON PAYS TRIBUTE TO THE THREE DECEASED COVID-19 PHYSICIANS -----

"I also want to pay tribute this evening to the caregivers who have paid with their lives for their commitment to caring for other lives, saving other lives since the beginning of this epidemic. The first caregiver fell a few days ago. Three caregivers lost their lives in the Grand-Est region, they had decided to treat all costs. An obstetrician gynecologist here in Mulhouse, a general practitioner in the commune of the hospital in Moselle and a general practitioner in Colmar, a city also very badly affected, our thoughts go out to their families, loved ones and the entire caregiver community.

My dear compatriots, I told you a few days ago that we were engaged in a war, a war against an invisible enemy, this virus, the Covid-19 and this city, this territory bears the bites of it. When we start a war, we engage in it entirely, we mobilize in unity. I see in our country the factors of division, the doubts, all those who would like to fracture the country today when we must have only one obsession: to be united to fight the virus. I appeal to this unity, to this commitment: to be united. You have a Government that is at work, working to find solutions and fighting. The Minister of Health will return in the coming days, as he has already done and as he does constantly on the most sensitive subjects, with complete transparency." Said French President Macron

PRESIDENT MACRON RESTORES MEDICAL TEAMS IN ANGER BECAUSE OF MASK SHORTAGE-----

The French President Macron He wanted to reassure the medical teams who uttered several cries of alert and rescue by asking the government to deliver masks, because they work without masks, since the shortage which turned out to be catastrophic in full epidemic of COVID- 19 and their growing position of being subject directly to the risks of contagion. "The subject of masks, respirators, tests and treatments to provide all the explanations, all the requests for legitimate information, but without giving in to any form of division without ever giving in to the flow of false information . We have only one priority: to beat the virus. » President Macron acknowledged « The entire Nation is mobilized. Mobilization of state services first, which is total, and here in the Grand-Est from the start. On the health front, first of all, everything is done so that the service, our health services can face the wave. The Regional Health Agency launched a call for volunteers from nursing staff very early on. More than 1,000 participants responded present in the region, including 250 here in Mulhouse. An organization has been implemented consisting in de-scheduling operations that were not urgent to free beds, mobilizing the private sector, bringing into play all the solidarity between the hospital, the private sector and the city. Respirators have arrived, from other hospitals, from the Armed Forces. A full deployment has been made. Here in this region, we have set up an organization, a new method which will be replicated wherever it is useful. »... TO be continued next article

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
